In order to recognize the careers of these outstanding attorneys and members of our local bar, the LBA is establishing an LBA Hall of Fame. The Hall of Fame Award shall be presented to honor the contributions these exceptional lawyers have made to the legal profession, the Bar or the public. We are seeking nominations for attorneys to be considered for election to the inaugural class of the LBA Hall of Fame. A cocktail party and reception shall be held in late summer/early fall to publicly recognize the inductees. The criteria for consideration for election into the Hall of Fame is set out herein below:

Induction into the Lafayette Bar Association Hall of Fame shall be presented as a lifetime contribution award to LBA members who have achieved a high degree of professional achievement or who have displayed long term outstanding leadership and participation in the activities of the Bar. Recipients shall meet the following standards and qualifications:

- Have attained the age of 70; and,
- Have a professional career marked by the highest standards of ethical conduct, professionalism, civility and collegiality; and
- Have demonstrated outstanding contributions and commitment to the legal profession, the Lafayette Bar Association or the community; or
- Have attained a high degree of professional achievement.

Inclusion in the LBA Hall of Fame is intended to recognize an exemplary career as an attorney or dedicated service to the community or the Bar.
