**15TH JUDICIAL DISTRICT COURT'S MODIFICATION AND ADDENDUM  
OF PHASE ONE AND PHASE TWO OF EMERGENCY ORDERS  
RELATIVE TO COVID-19 PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY  
PARISHES OF ACADIA, LAFAYETTE AND VERMILION**


In light of the COVID-19 public health emergency, the state of emergency declaration issued by Governor John Bel Edwards on March 13, 2020, the additional measures contained in his Proclamation JBE 2020-30 issued on March 16, 2020, his Order allowing re-opening pursuant to Phase One guidelines and his Proclamation 74JBE2020 issued on June 4, 2020 entering Phase Two and his Proclamation 101JBE2020 renewing the Phase Two Order through August 28, 2020; the Orders of the Louisiana Supreme Court of April 6, 2020, April 22, 2020 and April 29, 2020; the emergency declarations issued by Lafayette Mayor President Josh Guillory; the Fifteenth Judicial District Court issues the following modification and addendum to its Orders relative to re-opening pursuant to Phase One and Phase Two, and issues the following Order for the Parishes of Acadia, Vermilion and Lafayette:

ALL PROVISIONS OF THE 15TH JUDICIAL DISTRICT COURT'S PHASE ONE EMERGENCY ORDER OF MAY 13, 2020 AND PHASE TWO ORDER OF JUNE 5, 2020 REMAIN IN EFFECT WITH THE FOLLOWING ADDITION/MODIFICATION:

The courthouses in the Parishes of Acadia, Lafayette and Vermilion shall resume normal hours of operation with an opening at 8:30 a.m. and closing at 4:30 p.m.

This Order shall be effective beginning at 12:01 AM on August 14, 2020 and shall remain in effect until further orders are issued.
