EMERGENCY ORDER NO. 5

In light of the COVID-19 public health emergency, the state of emergency declaration issued by Governor John Bel Edwards on March 13, 2020, the Stay at Home Order issued March 22, 2020, the extension of that Order to April 30, 2020 and the further extension of that Order until May 15, 2020; the Orders issued by the Louisiana Supreme Court on March 16, March 20 March 23, 2020, April 6, 2020 and April 22, 2020, and the guidelines set forth by the Center for Disease Control and Cyber and Infrastructure Security Agency, the Court issues the following Order for Carencro City Court:

- 1. Any and all trials previously scheduled on March 26, 2020, April 30, 2020 and May 7, 2020 are hereby continued and will be rescheduled to **June 4, 2020**. All persons under Summons to appear for trial on March 26, 2020 and/or April 30, 2020 and/or May 7, 2020, must now appear on **June 4, 2020** at Carencro City Hall unless advised otherwise by the Clerk.
- 2. All trial dates after June 4, 2020 remain intact.
- 3. A Summons will be issued to all defendants for the new trial date. You may receive the new Summons by mail or you may be contacted by the Clerk by telephone, advising of the new trial date and instructing that you must pick up the new Summons. It is the defendant's responsibility to ensure that the court has your current address and contact information. If your address has changed, you must provide your new address and contact information to the Clerk. You must include your full name as it appears on your

ticket or old Summons, your Case/Citation number and your new address including city, state and zip code. You can provide any new contact information to the Clerk by phone at 337-896-6132, by fax at 337-896-1937 or email at info@carencropd.com.

- 4. If you were scheduled for trial in March or April or on May 7, 2020 and have not received a new Summons for June 4, 2020 by May 20, 2020, or have any other question about whether or not you should appear, please call the Clerk of Court at 337-896-6132.
- 5. Should you decide to change your plea, pay the fine, and avoid a trial please contact the Clerk at the phone number above by May 21, 2020

This Order shall remain in effect until further Order of this Court.
